- **From CWH Physio Dept**

The Physio department will be restarting their group antenatal classes face to face at Christchurch Women's Hospital. As you are aware they have been doing telehealth for the past few months with women.

They are also seeing all their postnatal referrals within their triage times. They do like to triage the postnatal referrals appropriately and see them in a timely manner, under 6 weeks and are seeing most much sooner

They do acknowledge that there is a longer waiting time for non-obstetric patients with prolapse, urinary incontinence and pelvic pain including dyspareunia

They are prioritising all 3rd and 4th degree perineal injuries to be seen within two weeks. As you are aware there are changes coming with ACC. We are lucky here in Chch that there are quite a lot of physios in the community offering Women's Health, however women should be given the opportunity of the public system as they do offer a free service.

- **Festive List Women**

There was an email that went out on 11/06/22 with an update regarding the Festive List. For those who did not receive it here are some of the key points

- Thank you to all the midwives who have worked together with the MRC to ensure the women due over the festive period are receiving antenatal care in a timely fashion
- The MRC will continue collating a list of women unable to find a midwife, and will continue working with you and them to facilitate care but are now asking that you contact the MRC if you have the capacity to help any of these women.
- If you are providing antenatal care to women on the Festive List please advise the MRC of the dates you will be unavailable from if you haven't done so already. The MRC need to know if you are completely handing these women over or if there is a specific period that you are away/off call but happy to provide care outside of these dates.
- Provide the following details for Festive women in your care:
Women's full name, address, DOB, NHI, ethnicity, parity, blood type, intended place of birth and any other clinical information you feel is relevant for other care providers to know about.
